# 7.1. Organization Update:

# 7.1.1. Safe Reopening Update by Jason Watts, COO and Sarah-Schoenfeld Nakamoto, Chief Compliance Officer.

Jason Watts presented an update on the October 19th reopening of the Oceanside campus. The Oceanside staff were well-prepared and Home Office staff came and assisted during the drop off and dismissals. The classrooms are occupied at 50% capacity or less as more students opted for Distance Learning. Mr. Watts mentioned all of the safety preparations that were done to have the Oceanside campus ready: masks, face shields for staff, shields at each student desk, mobile shield for the front of the classroom, healthy hygiene signage, air filtratration systems, additional hand washing stations and the StopIt Screener.

# 7.2. Oceanside Campus Update by Valerie Douglass, Principal.

Valerie Douglass updated the Board on the status of the Oceanside campus reopening for hybrid learning with an am and pm shift. The drop off and pick up processes went well the first day and the second day saw more efficiency as students knew where to go, and parents understood the procedures.

# 7.3. Santa Ana Campus Update by Dennise Allotey, Principal.

Dennise Allotey noted that the Santa Ana campus is following Oceanside closely, and the leaders will continue to collaborate and learn from each other. Parents are being notified of the am and pm cohorts and that students will keep their same teachers.

# 7.4. South Bay Campus Update by Harris Luu, Principal.

Harris Luu commented that the South Bay campus has no set reopening date as LA County is still in the Purple tier for Covid cases. Their emphasis is on preparation for when the campus can reopen. This year's enrollment is up by 52 students.

Board Member candidate Leandro Otero was introduced by Andrew Crowe. Mr. Otero is an educator and brings his experience as a classroom English teacher, charter school recruiter and now as a managing director for Teach For America to the Board.
